Thanks so much for registering for the *Felter's Rendezvous*. I know we're going to have a great week of felting! My apologies for this long email, but there are a lot of logistics to share. For starters, the address for the <u>Y of the Rockies</u> is 2515 Tunnel Road, Estes Park, CO 80511. Get a pdf version of this email (for easy copying) by clicking here.

The <u>*Rendezvous*</u> will be held in the *Central Lodges* portion of the property. This year, we will be in the *Rams Horn Lodge*. The <u>attached map</u> shows you how to get to the lodge once you are on the property. Click <u>here</u> for directions to Estes Park from Denver.

Rendezvous classes will be held in either *Rams Horn* or *Emerald Mountain* Lodge as indicated on the **attached** <u>Schedule of Events</u>.

Workshop registration opens 4pm, Friday, March 2nd and will be in the *Teddy's Teeth* and *Giant Track* rooms of the *Rams Horn Lodge*. Follow the signage up the stairs. *TIP:* You may want to leave your luggage downstairs until you learn where your room is!

If you signed up for meals, you'll receive your tickets along with your registration packet, room key, and name badge. If you did not pre-order meals, you can purchase additional meals directly from <u>YMCA of the Rockies</u> in the dining hall at the time of the meal.

The Rendezvous Fiber Marketplace will be open for business starting Friday 4-6pm until and then throughout the day each day during classes, about 8AM-5PM. The <u>workshop materials lists that are on the website</u> (along with each class description) indicates which of the class materials will be available for sale at the Marketplace and which pieces of equipment we have available to borrow.

TIP: If you would like to borrow anything starred * on the materials lists (pool noodles, towels, risers, etc.), please <u>contact me directly</u> and I will hold them for you to pick up at our workshop registration. The Marketplace will also offer finished goods from some of the instructors if you are interested in purchasing directly from the fabulous maker.

NOTE: We also are planning a *Meet the Instructors* night on Sunday evening.

Classes run from 9:00am-4:00pm so if you are driving in, please make sure you allow enough time to register, to get to your classroom, and to set up your materials before class begins. Thank you!

If you are flying in, <u>Estes Park Shuttle</u> runs between Denver International Airport (DIA) and the town of Estes Park and stops at the headquarters building of the Y of the Rockies. The shuttle cost is \$85 round trip, or \$45 1-way. You can make a reservation on their web site, <u>www.estesparkshuttle.com</u>.

TIP: The shuttle drops off at the administration building and not our lodge. Sometimes they will, if asked nicely, bring you up to the *Rams Horn Lodge*. If not, ask someone in the admin building to call us in the *Rams Horn Combo Room* and someone will come get you.

If you are driving in, directions to the facility are located <u>here</u> on their website.

TIP: Highway 34 out of Loveland is closed to Estes Park. You will need to take *Highway 36* (from Lyons--Hwy 66 off I-25) to get to Estes Park.

We're sure happy about bringing such wonderful felting instructors to Colorado. We look forward to seeing you there!
